EPTS: Summer School 2024

European integration brings regions closer together, even across borders. Public transport services and timetables need to be coordinated to establish smooth and smart travel chains from point to point. 15% of the European population have some kind of disability and many more people are exposed to barriers in specific situations like carrying heavy luggage, travelling with a stroller, a broken leg or broken glasses. Moreover, a different country often means a different language.

In our summer school we will take all this into account and discuss what is necessary for convenient cross-border public transport, which is barrier-free, accessible and inclusive. We will do this not only by the input of experts and people with disabilities but also by self-experience.

The city of Maribor is a picturesque gem in Slovenia, close to the Austrian border, combining tradition and modern lifestyle. Registration for the summer school is open for students of all academic levels (Bachelor; Master, Doctoral) and will start in September 2023. The results shall serve as a role model for a series of new summer schools in the following years. Furthermore, the results shall be reported to the European Commission and shall be applied to similar cross-border settings within the EU.
