The conference partner is The European Platform of Transport Sciences, which brings together universities and scientific transport associations from 18 European countries.

Particularly important will be discussions on the role of innovative transport solutions in the development of smart and sustainable logistics, shifting mobility patterns, and achieving transport decarbonization goals.
